Use visuals: People tend get more traffic on social media when they use visuals. You may use digital cards available on www.forSafeWorship.org.

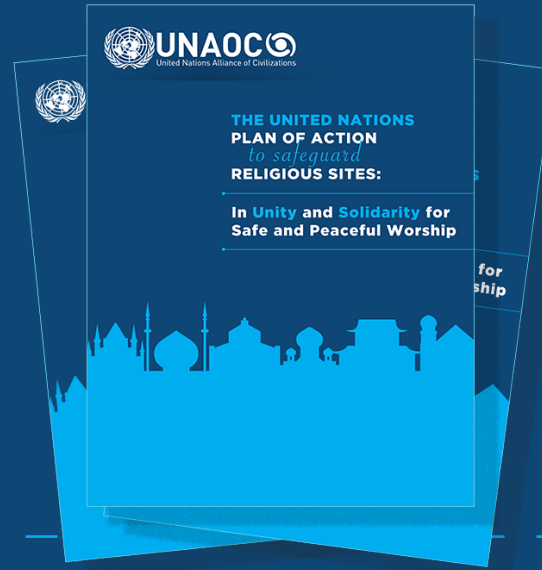




Engage your community by tagging them in your posts so they may learn about the call to action #forSafeWorship and get involved.
